Justin left his position at the highest level of global account management for Coca-Cola to launch Four String Farm in Rockport, TX. He transformed the raw wilderness into the most successful small-scale farm in the region using methods he learned from history books and from studying small-scale farms around the world.

Justin is creator and host of "Your Wholesome Heritage Garden", a weekly radio program on KEDT-FM that reaches Corpus Christi, Victoria, McAllen, and Brownsville. He is a columnist and feature writer for The Bend Magazine in Corpus Christi and EastSIDE Magazine in Austin.

He has been featured in The Washington Times, USA Today Agriculture Report, Corpus Christi Caller-Times, KRIS-6 TV, the Heritage Radio Network, and other publications. Justin is a former US Army Ranger. He graduated Magna cum Laude from Texas A&M—Corpus Christi. Justin is married to dietitian/author/chef Kayla Butts, author of the international cookbook Garden to Table (Fox Chapel Publishing). They live with their children at Four String Farm in Rockport.
